After graduating from university, Dr. Toshifumi Matsuoka worked as an engineer at an oil company and was involved in geophysical exploration works in oil and gas fields for about 20 years. After he retired from Kyoto University, he has been at Fukada Geological Institute. During this period, he has served as a member of expert committees for CCS projects in Japan.

Dr. Toshifumi Matsuoka holds a Bachelor of Science and a Master of Science degree in Physics from Tokyo University of Science and a Doctor of Engineering from The University of Tokyo.
